This event is only for Chapparral Residents and their disposal items. When dumping at these events you will be asked to show identification and your name and address will be verified against the current resident database.

Please remember that smaller brush and limbs will be taken on the normal trash pick-up days if placed in a WM can, so we ask that you only bring larger items to the dumpsters for this event.

Any trash items or recyclables that can regularly be picked up by WM during the week should not be brought to the dumpsters. We have limited space for this event, and that space is even more limited if anyone disregards this by bringing their regular weekly trash.

Bulk Item Disposal - Rolloff

Homeowners are invited to bring all bulk trash items to our community cleanup event. Please follow these guidelines to help keep our neighborhood clean and safe.

Guidelines

- All items **must be put into the container**. Do not leave any items on the ground or hanging over the edge of the container.
- Items may not be over the top of the container as it has to be hauled on streets and highways. We can't have debris that may fly out.
- Please be careful when lifting items into the container.
- Do not climb into the container for any reason, as this is a serious safety hazard.

Items NOT Acceptable For Bulk Trash Removal

- Appliances including:
 - Refrigerators/Freezers
 - Ice Makers
 - Washers/Dryers
 - Stoves
 - Dishwashers
 - Water Heaters
 - Air Conditioners
 - Appliances with Freon
- Electronics including:
 - Televisions
 - Computers
- Tires
- Batteries
- Fluorescent bulbs and/or ballasts
- 55-gallon drums
- Chemicals including:
 - Pesticides
 - Oil
 - Paint
 - Turpentine
 - Any flammable liquids
- Propane/Gas Cylinders
- Asbestos Material
- Medical Waste
- Contaminated soil or any liquid hazardous waste
- Railroad ties
- Construction material
